

University Oval Terms & Conditions Of Entry

To ensure that all patrons enjoy their experience at the University Oval, entry to the ground is subject to the following conditions

Patron and bag searches

- All patrons and their possessions may be subject to searches before entering the ground
- Searches may also be carried out during an event and when leaving the ground
- Patrons who refuse to participate in searches may be denied entry to the ground or asked to leave the venue
- All vehicles entering and leaving the ground may be searched
- Prohibited items will be confiscated

Playing surface

- Patrons are not allowed inside the playing boundary fence, before, during or after an event
- For some events, access to the playing field may be permitted to patrons holding valid tickets. Patrons must follow the directions of University Oval staff

Patrons may be refused entry to the University Oval if they

- Have no valid entry ticket or accreditation pass
- Appear intoxicated/under the influence of drugs or exhibit disorderly behaviour
- Fail to comply with gate staff or security requests
- Are in possession of prohibited items
- Have been previously served with a trespass notice that still applies

Patrons will be asked to leave the University Oval if they

- Use obscene language
- Are verbally or physically abusive or behave in an offensive manner
- Are intoxicated
- Are carrying out unauthorised activities within the University Oval
- Throw items into the air or onto the pitch (including during Mexican waves)
- Fail to comply with these policies

Patrons may not bring into the University Oval

- Alcohol
- Illicit drugs
- Glass bottles or cans
- Sound amplifiers including loudhailers
- Recording devices for commercial purposes
- Dogs or other pets (guide dogs are permitted)
- Flares, fireworks, laser pointers
- Knives or other dangerous weapons
- Skateboards, roller blades, scooters or bicycles
- Flag poles of more than one metre in length
- Signs or banners that are obscene, offensive or abusive
- Any other item that University Oval management determine may cause injury or public nuisance or inconvenience to any other person
- Sofas

Items that are allowed

- Thermos flasks
- Plastic bottles
- Chilly bins, picnic baskets
- Prams, strollers, pushchairs
- Chairs
- Small amounts of food for personal consumption such as sandwiches, fruit, chips, cakes

- Plastic water bottles up to 1 litre in size

General

- Patrons must not sit or stand in aisles, or block emergency doors or emergency exits
- Some sporting and other activities are dangerous. Patrons viewing such activities do so at their own risk.
- Clothing must conform to reasonable standards of decency.
- Radios, CD's etc may be used only with earphones
- Cameras, videos, tape recorders and other recording devices may be prohibited for certain events
